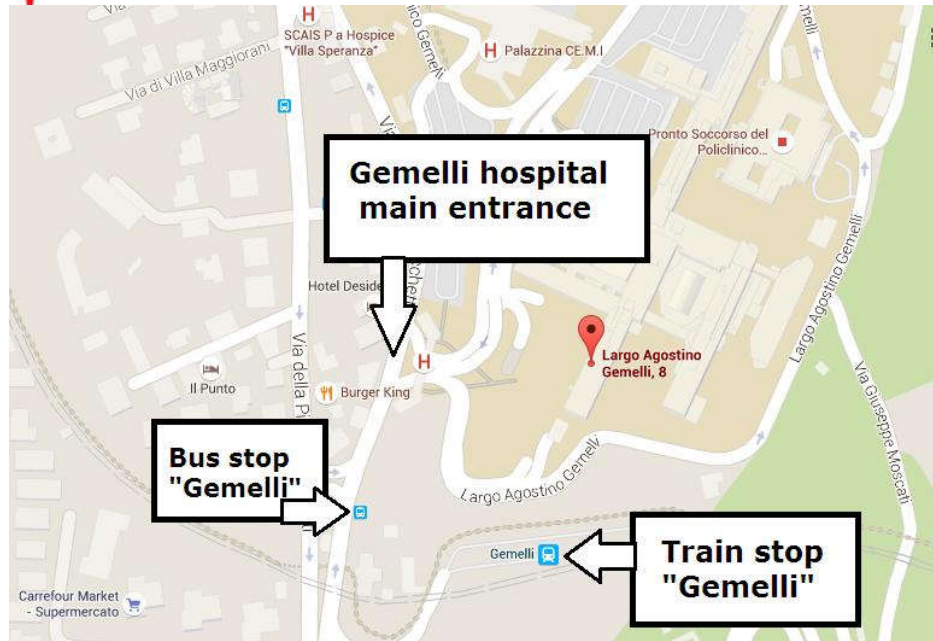


Figure 1 - UCSC/Gemelli Hospital map



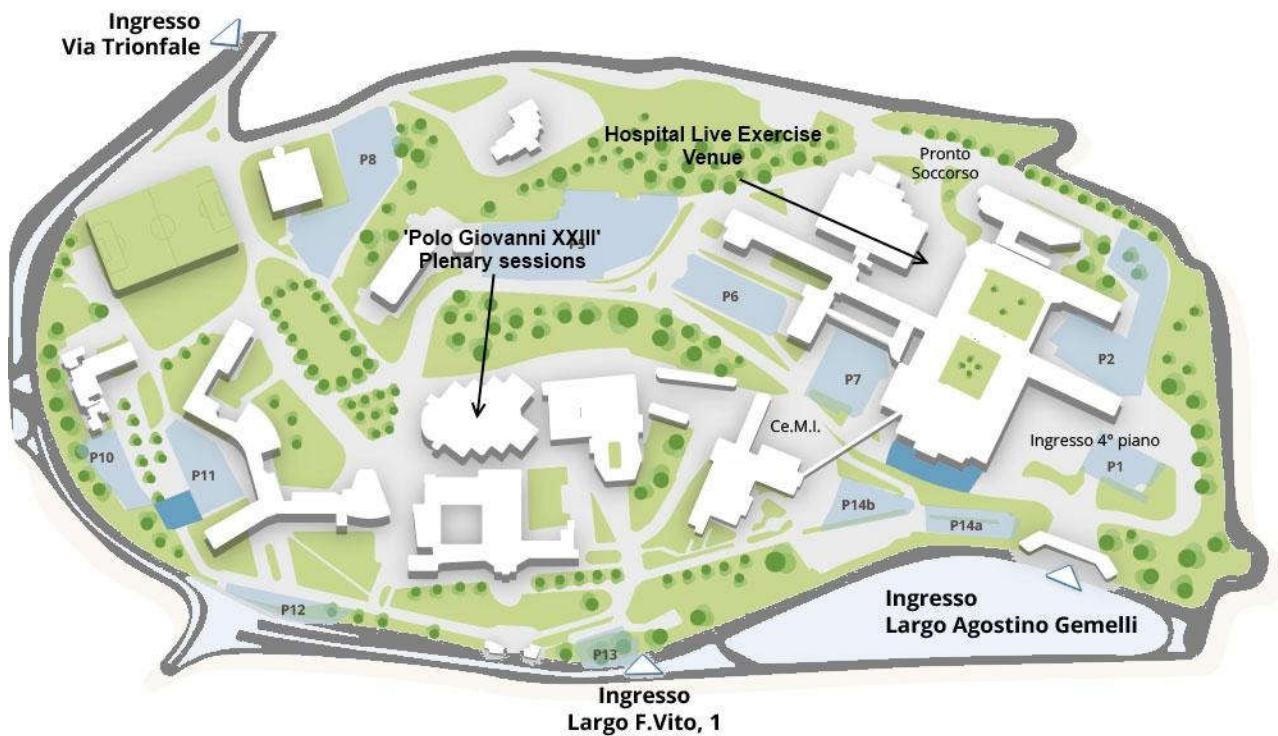
Figure 2 - Main entrance of UCSC/Gemelli Hospital

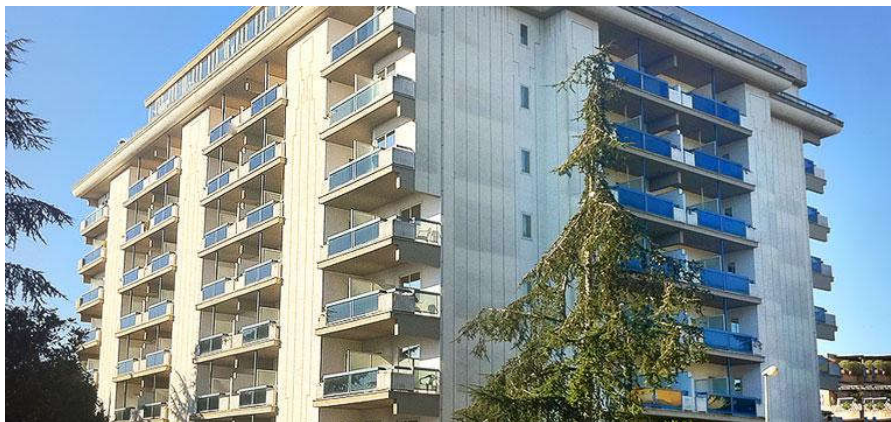


Figure 5 – Hotel Pineta Palace

There are plenty of hotels downtown. If you would like to stay close to the city center please make sure that the hotel is next to a railway station of the FL3 line (Roma S. Pietro, Quattro Venti, Roma Trastevere, Roma Ostiense)

2.6 Transportation

Transfer from Fiumicino Airport:

This document is produced under the EC Grant Agreement No **786670**. It is the property of the NO-FEAR consortium and shall not be modified or used without the formal approval of the NO-FEAR Project Coordinator.

At the Fiumicino Airport train station take the line FL1 direction Settebagni/Orte/Magliano Sabina (alternative destinations, all good). After 5 stops get off at "Trastevere" station. From there take the line FL3 direction Cesano/La Storta/Bracciano/Viterbo (alternative destinations, all good). After 5 stops get off at "Gemelli" station. The average transfer time is 50 min.

Transfer from Ciampino Airport:

Take the bus 520 from Ciampino Airport to the "Anagnina - Metro A" subway terminal.

Take underground line "A" towards the "Battistini" terminal and get off at Valle Aurelia (23rd stop). Then take the FL3 direction Cesano/La Storta/Bracciano/Viterbo (alternative destinations, all good) and get off at "Gemelli" station. The average transfer time is 1h and 30 min.

Alternative from Fiumicino and Ciampino to downtown Rome (Vatican and Termini station)

Take a shuttle bus of SITbus (<http://www.sitbusshuttle.com/en/>) or Terravision (<http://www.terravision.com>). The average transfer time is 50 min.

2.7 Other information

TIME:

Time zone: Central European Time (CET). In November it is CET (Central European Time), UTC+1 hour.

WEATHER:

ELECTRICAL POWER:

In Italy the standard voltage is 230 V. The standard frequency is 50 Hz. The power sockets that are used are of type F (also works with plug C and E) and L (that works also with plug C).
